



How to obtain non owned insurance to satisfy Fly Time Aviation

Overview & Purpose

This lesson will walk you through the Fly Time Aviation procedures for obtaining non owned insurance to operate Fly Time Aviation aircraft.

Activity

1. Non owned insurance is a requirement to operate Fly Time Aviation aircraft. A minimum policy of \$25,000 is required.
2. Shopping for the non owned insurance is completely the renters responsibility. There are three reputable aviation insurance companies listed on Flytimeaviation.com.
3. The incentive offered to offset the cost of a \$25,000 policy, which has been found to be less than \$340, is 4 dry rental hours.
4. Please email a copy of the policy to Carlee@flytimeaviation.com.
5. To utilize the 4 dry hours of rental time,notate in the notes section of the reservation that you have used your dry hour rental time.
6. The 4 dry hours shall be used in 1 hour intervals once a calendar month.
7. The dry hour will not include the cost of fuel, but the fuel used for the dry hour should be notated in the notes section as well.
